

Millenium Senior International Bowling Championships

6th - 10th November 2000
Plaza Bowl, Singapore

1 OBJECTIVE

The objective of this Championships is to foster and promote goodwill, friendship and sponsorship amongst the local and foreign senior bowling fraternity.

2 ORGANISATION

The Senior International Bowling Championships is organised by Bowlmaster Pro Ltd and sanctioned by the Singapore Tenpin Bowling Congress and ASIAN BOWLING FEDERATION and the FIQ-WTBA (World). FIQ-WTBA playing rules and regulations shall apply on matters not covered therein.

3 DATE & VENUE

This Championships will be held from 6th to 10th November 2000 at Plaza Bowl, Singapore.

4 ELIGIBILITY

All current STBC members of good standing and foreign bowlers accredited by their respective Congress/ Federation/ Association, who are born before 1st November 1950 are eligible to participate in this Championships.

5 CLASSIFICATION

All registered male & female bowlers, regardless of bowling average, are qualified to participate in this Championships.

5.1 Handicap

In order to make the tournament more competitive, points (pinfalls) will be given as follows:

- One point per year (age) for bowlers above 55 years old.
- Additional 7 points (pinfalls) per game for all women bowlers.

5.2 Team Combination

A combination of bowlers from different age groups and sexes will be permitted for the doubles and team events. The bonus pinfalls in para 5.1(i) & (ii) shall apply.

6 STYLE OF PLAY

Each game shall be bowled on a pair of lanes. Teams and/or individuals shall successfully and in regular order bowl one frame on a lane and the next frame on the alternate adjoining lane, hence alternating each frame until 5 frames are bowled on each lane for each game. When any situation arises as to which of the two bowlers should bowl first, it is incumbent that the bowler on the right has the right of way.

7 TOURNAMENT EVENTS

Men and Women shall compete in the same category except for all Masters Event.

7.1 Singles Event

Six (6) games per bowler in one single block played over one day. Lane Change after every game.

7.2 Doubles Event

Six (6) games per bowler in one single block played over one day with 2 bowlers scheduled per lane. Lane change after every game.

7.3 Team Event (Quarter)

Six (6) games per bowler in one single block played over one day with a team of 4 bowlers scheduled per lane. Lane change after every game.

7.4 All Events

The All-Events standing shall be computed from the foregoing 18 games in the Singles, Doubles and Team Events.

8.1 MASTERS (1st Round)

(a) Men's Division

- 36 bowlers based on the All-Events standing shall bowl a new series of 6 games starting from scratch. The handicap spelt out in Para 5.1(i) shall apply.

- The top 10 bowlers based on the total pinfalls shall move into the Final Round.

(b) Ladies Division

- The top 8 bowlers based on the All-Events standing shall move into the Final Round.

8.2 MASTERS (Final Round)

(a) Men's Division

The top 10 bowlers shall bowl another series of 6 games starting from scratch to determine the final standing position. The handicap spelt out in para 5.1(ii) shall apply.

(b) Ladies Division

The top 8 bowlers shall bowl a series of 6 games will determining the standing in the Position Round. The last game (6th) of the Final Round shall be a Position Round. The handicap spelt out in para 5.1(ii) shall apply.

NOTE : The total pinfalls after the 5th game will determine the standing in the Position Round. The last game (6th) of the Final Round shall be a Position Round.

9 ENTRIES & ENTRY FEE

All Entries must be submitted on the prescribed Entry form accompanied by the Entry Fee of US\$200.00 per bowler.

Closing date is 16th October 2000.
