TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

OBJECTIVE

This tournament is organized to bring together in Dubai bowlers from around the world in the spirit of goodwill and to promote the bowling sport. This is an Asian ranking tournament towards the World Ranking Masters Finals.

1. Sanction & Playing Rules

The tournament is sanctioned by EBF, ABF and WTBA, and playing rules will be in accordance with WTBA standards.

2. Eligibility

This tournament is open to all local and international male and female bowlers in good standing with their federations/associations/clubs.

3. Divisions

The tournament will be played in three divisions as follows:

- Open Division
 - Open to Men, Women & Youth bowlers
 - Women will receive +8 points handicap per game up to the final rounds.
- 23 Years & Under
 - Boys & Girls who are 23 years old and under (born on 1 January 1988 or later) qualify in this division.
 - Passport copy will be required as proof of age.
- Women's Division
 - Open to all women bowlers.
- Players in the lower divisions can participate in the open division.

4. Format

ROUND 1: QUALIFYING ROUND


- Participants must bowl a total of 9 games in blocks of 3 games.
- Each 3-game block will be played on a pair of lanes.
- Lane assignments will be by draw.
- Participants may bowl multiple entries with the highest 3 blocks to count towards the 9-game total.
- Open Division:


Top 26 + Top 2 UAE locals will advance to Round 2.

Top 10 qualifiers will advance to the Semi-Final round.

Women's Division:

Top 10 qualifiers will advance to the Final Round.

Lane movement: One pair of lanes after every game. Bowler assigned on the left lane moves 2 lanes to the left while bowler assigned on right lane moves 2 lanes to the right.

Entry Fees AED. 370 (US\$100) AED. 260 (US\$ 70) AED. 510 (US\$140) Registration (with 1 squad): AED. 80 (US\$ 22) AED. 75 (US\$ 20) AED. 150 (US\$ 40) Entry Fee (per squad): AED. 180 (US\$ 50) Semi-Final & Final Rounds: AED. 290 (US\$ 80) AED. 370(US\$ 100)

Entries on first come, first served basis.

6. Refund

Entry fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable. Any participant who fails to show up for the scheduled squad will be disqualified and the entry fees forfeited.

5. Dress Code

Bowlers are required to be dressed with a sense of decorum and in accordance with accepted standards.

6. Tie Breakers

Last qualifying position & Last Semi-Final Round Position:

One-game roll off (immediately after the round where the tie occurs)--- Should there be a further tie, the 9th & 10th frames roll-off will be used and repeated until the tie is broken.

Final Positions:

- Positions 1 to 4: One-game roll off Should there be a further tie, the 9th & 10th frames roll-off will be used and repeated until the tie is broken.
- For ties in any of final positions from 5th to 28th, prizes will be combined and divided by the number of winners in the tied positions.

7. Prizes

- Prizes will be awarded to the following finalists (See separate list for breakdown):
 - Top 28 Open Division
 - Top 10 Youth Division
 - Top 10 Women's Division

8. Schedule

9. Pacers

No pacers are allowed throughout the Tournament unless appointed by the Tournament Management.





10. Interrupted Game(s)

The Tournament Manager or his appointed official(s) on duty may authorize the completion of a game and/or series on another pair of lanes when equipment failure on the starting lanes delays the normal progress of the series. An interrupted game and/or series, which cannot be completed, must resume from the points of interruption.

12. Bowling on Wrong Lane

When the bowler(s) bowl(s) on the wrong lane(s) and the error is discovered before another bowler has bowled, a dead ball shall be declared and the bowler(s) will be required to re-bowl on the correct lane(s). If the error is not discovered until the opposing bowler has bowled, the score shall count and the bowler shall be required to bowl his subsequent frame(s) on the correct lane.

13. Loss of Score during Black-outs/Power Failure or Equipment Failure

In the event of power failure/TV monitor black out or equipment failure in the progress of the game, and game scores could not be traced after power supply resumes, bowler(s) concerned have to re-bowl that particular game. However, previous games where the score have been duly recorded shall remain unchanged.

14. Protests:

For protest and appeal procedures, WTBA Rules 3.9 & 3.10 will be observed.

15. Interpretation Clause:

- In case of various interpretations of these rules, the Tournament Management's interpretation prevails.
- Matters not covered herein will be decided upon by the Tournament Management in accordance with standard rules, and the decision shall be final.
