► Format

1. Division

- 1) Open division
- 2) Open women's division
- 3) Senior's division

2. Eligibility

- 1) Open division: All international participants available (Men's, Women's, Senior's)
- 2) Open women's division: All international participants available (Only Women's)
- 3) Senior's division: Any bowlers who were born before November 1964

3. Qualification round format

- 1) Open men's & women's division

There are 3 games in a squad. His or her best 3-squad score (9 games) will be used for the qualification. A bowler can try as many squads as he/she/senior wants to.

(Handicap: Women's +8 each games)

- 2) Women's division

There are 3 games in a squad. His or her best 3-squad score (9 games) will be used for the qualification.

3) Senior's division

As same as open division

Handicap is based on the regulation of the Korea Senior Bowling Federation.

4. Final-round format

1) Open division

- ① The top 120 qualifiers will proceed to the final round
Local division (50), International division (20), Local & International Mixture(49), The winner in 2013(1)
- ② The total 16 game pinfalls will be used as the qualifying score.
The best 5 bowlers will advance to the TV final.

2) Open women's division

- ① The top 45 qualifiers will proceed to the final round.
Local division (15), International division (10), Local & International Mixture(19), The winner in 2013(1)
- ② The total 9 game pinfalls will be used as the qualifying score.
The best 2 bowlers will advance to the TV final

3) Senior's division

- 1) The top 45 qualifiers will proceed to the final round.
- 2) The total 6 game pinfalls will be used as the qualifying score.
The top 5 bowlers will advance to shoot-out decision and step-ladder.
(Step-ladder format after shootout decision for 3, 4, 5th)
- 3) Handicapped: ① A male senior player will get +1 per game after 1958 date of birth
② A female senior player will get +1 per game after 1958 date of birth
and+12 per game additionally

5. Registration fee

50.000won per each person (same as all division)

6. Squad fee

1. Open men's division: 50,000 won per squad (3 games)
2. Open women's division: 25,000 won per squad (3 games)
3. Senior's division: 15,000 won per squad (3 games)

7. Final round entry fee

1. Open men's division: 250,000 won
2. Open women's division: 150,000 won
3. Senior's division: 100,000 won








3. TV Final Match (Men's division)

Rules and Regulations

(1) Verification of Scores

It is the responsibility of each of the bowler to verify the correctness of each game on the official score sheet to accurately confirm the applicant's obligation to sign.

(2) Interrupted Games

- 2.1 Tournament Director can approve the delayed game and ending situation from equipment failure.
- 2.2 If the match game history lost and deleted because of the issue of equipment failure or power supply,
 Tournament Director's discretion can start a new game after rearranging the equipment.
 However, all of the completed game scores can not change the score record sheet.
- 2.3 If more than one game cannot be recalled, the series shall be declared null and void and a fresh series be rescheduled.
- 2.4 If only one single frame is missing, the bowler shall continue from the last frame

bowled.

(3) Registration of Bowling Ball, Illegality and Disqualification.

All bowlers are advised to check that their bowling balls used in the Tournament is certified as legal for weight and other specifications.

If any time a bowler is found to have used an illegal ball even if previously certified legal by the Tournament Office,

he/she shall be disqualified from the entire Tournament and stripped of all his/her winnings or positions standing and if the Tournament Committee is of the opinion that such usage was deliberate and was intended to cheat, he/she may be further reported to the KPBA Disciplinary Committee or ABF Executive Committee for additional penalization.

He/she may also be asked to return immediately to one of the

Tournament Directors any awards that may have already been given to him/her.

(4) Altering Bowling Ball Surface

Altering the surface of bowling balls is allowed in a designated area during the official practice session, during the practice session immediately preceding a competition round.

A player may not alter the surface of the bowling ball during the block.

(5) Tie- Breaking Procedure

5.1 (Qualifying Round 1)

1) Qualified who has the small difference total pin falls of the 3 squads

2) 1) Qualified who has the small difference of the 9 games High/Low

3) 2) Qualified who has the High score in 9 games.

The above tie-breaking procedure conform all three divisions.

5.2 Masters

1) Open Division has the four-games in one series.

The four series of High/Low apply to the high rank.

Then the procedure is the same as 13.1

2) Open women Division has three-games in one series.

The three series of high/Low apply to the high Rank.

Then the procedure is the same as 13.1

3) Senior Division has three-games in one series.

The two series of high/Low apply to the high Rank.

Then the procedure is the same as 13.1

(6) Cheating.

Any bowler found guilty of cheating scores, averages eligibility or in any other counts will be immediately disqualified from the entire tournament and reported to the Disciplinary Committee and the Asian Bowling Federation for further action. He/she will also be striped of his/her winnings positions standing and be asked to return to the tournament Directors any awards that may have already been give to him/her. When in doubt, bowlers are reminded to consult the Tournament Directors on any issues.

Other not stated that the rule applies to WTBA Statutes and Playing Rules.
