Format:

Singles format. Men and women will bowl in different divisions but in the same format. There are eight (8) squads in two days (two in the first day and six in the second day) and each squad consists of 3 games. A bowler can try as many squads as he/she wants to, and his/her best 3-game score will be used for the qualification. The best 36 male and the best 24 female bowlers will qualify for the respective divisions of the main Championships to be held from January 17-19, 2013 in

Inazawa Grand Bowl.

Playing rules:

WTBA Rules and Regulations 2013 and basic rules for DHC International Bowling Championships 2013 will apply to the Qualification squads.

Tie Breaker:

In case a tie occurs on the cut line for the main championships, one game roll off will be played to break the tie. In case of an additional tie, 9-10 frame roll off will be played until the tie breaks. In other cases, the bowlers with the same score will share the position and the next position should be vacant.

Eligibility:

Non-Japanese Bowlers. Certification is needed from WTBA Member federation, which the bowler has the membership of. (WTBA Statutes and Playing Rules). Because of the center capacity, maximum number of bowlers is 100 (men and women in total) and registration will be on first come first served basis.

Squad fee:

US\$50 per squad – No other entry fee is needed.

Visa:

<u>PBA</u> and <u>KPBA</u> bowlers need to get the Certificate of Authorized Employment (CAE) from the Immigration Bureau of Japan. It will be granted through the organizer. First of all, make an entry, the organizer will assist to get the CAE. After getting the CAE, the applicant will have to go to nearby Japanese Counselor's office with the CAE to get the VISA. Please note that it will usually take two months or more to get the CAE.

Other bowlers will follow the ordinary procedure to enter Japan.
