- Tournament format : Bowlers will move lanes after each game.  
**Qualifying Round:** 8 games in two blocks. Top 56 bowlers will be qualified for semi-final.  
**Semi-final:** 4 games in one block with scores in the previous round carried forward. Top 16 bowlers will proceed to Final Rounds based on the scores of foregoing 12 games.

**Final:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Round:** 1 game matches between 16 qualifiers from Semi-final.  
Bowlers will be assigned to the lanes according to attached the tournament bracket.

※ Losers' positions will follow those from Semi-final

**2<sup>nd</sup> Round :** 1 game matches between 8 winners from 1<sup>st</sup> Round

※ Losers' positions will follow those from Semi-final

**3<sup>rd</sup> Round:** 1 game elimination match between 4 winners from 2<sup>nd</sup> Round.  
The lowest scored will be eliminated.

**4<sup>th</sup> Round:** 1 game elimination match between 3 winners from 3<sup>rd</sup> Round.  
The lowest scored will be eliminated.

**5<sup>th</sup> Round :** Championship match – 1 game match between two winners from 4<sup>th</sup> Round and to determine 'Fukuoka Summer Cup Champion'.

Handicap : ◇ This tournament has no separate division of genders or ages, but has a handicap system including for Final Round as follows:

※ Handicap

[ Age handicap ] 5 pins to junior high students

[ Gender handicap ] 7 pins to girls ; (ex.) 12 pins to junior high girls

Rules : World Bowling Playing Rules 2016 will be applied, except for the following tie breaker ( for Qualifying Round and Semi-final : ① → ⑤, for Final Rounds: ⑤ )

The highest positioned should be the one

① with the least difference between series.

② with the least difference between the highest and the lowest game of the games he/she bowled up to then.

③ with the most strikes.

④ with the most spares.

⑤ who won one shot roll off.

Eligibility : Bowlers born from 1994 to 2003. Certification is needed from ABF member federation for participation.

Entry Fee : USD120

Awards : Prize Money, supplementary prize and bowling equipments will be awarded to the winners of 1<sup>st</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> position by Storm.

Prize money : Champion - JPY330,000, 2<sup>nd</sup> positioned - JPY170,000,  
3<sup>rd</sup> positioned - JPY120,000, 4<sup>th</sup> positioned - JPY90,000  
5<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> positioned - JPY35,000, 9<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> positioned - JPY12,000
