6. Entry Fee: (Non-refundable)
- a) USD110/night/person for twin room.
  - b) USD150/night/person for single room.
  - c) Fee includes:
    - Hotel Accommodation and 3 meals per day
    - Transportation service to and from the Hong Kong International Airport and Regal Riverside Hotel
    - Victory Banquet

HKSAPD will reserve the hotel accommodation upon receipt of entry fees. Official Hotel WILL NOT accept private booking by participating countries.

9. Insurance: Participants must arrange their own travel, health, and personal accident insurance. Organizer would take no responsibility in respect of any medical and risks associated with the organization and staging of the Championships.
10. Visa: No visa for entry is required for more than 170 countries/regions. However, the visa-free period may vary among countries/ regions. The entry forms are NOT valid as visas. All countries/ regions should confirm visa information independently by checking “Part II of Visit Visa/ Entry Permit Requirements for the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region” from the Immigration Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region [www.immd.gov.hk/eng/services/visas/visit-transit/visit-visa-entry-permit.html](http://www.immd.gov.hk/eng/services/visas/visit-transit/visit-visa-entry-permit.html).
- Application form could be found in [www.immd.gov.hk/eng/forms/hk-visas/visit-transit.html](http://www.immd.gov.hk/eng/forms/hk-visas/visit-transit.html). The application process may take more than 6 weeks’ time. **All visa applications have to be done by Hong Kong SAR Immigration Department** and not through the Chinese Embassy in your country/territory. We earnestly request that **all filled out forms should be email to HKSAPD at least 2 months before the commencement of the championship** to facilitate our processing with the HKSAR Immigration Department.
11. National Anthem and Flags: All participating federations are reminded to bring along 3 national flags (1 meter x 2 meters) and 1 USB of their national anthem which will be collected by Organizing Committee upon their arrival.

## **Rules and Regulations**

1. Competition Rules: All rules and regulations will follow those presently adopted by the IBSA Rules and World Bowling Playing Rules as of September 2019.
2. Maximum Entry: Singles: 3 athletes per medal event  
Doubles: 2 teams per medal event  
Trios: 2 teams per medal event
3. Awards: Medals will be awarded to the Champion, the first and second runner-up of each event in the respective group.  
  
If there are only three (3) entries in any of the events, only the Champion and First Runner-up will be awarded.  
  
If there are only two (2) entries in any of the event, only the Champion will be awarded.
4. Classification: No Classification will be organized for Wheelchair and Physically Disabled. Participants should submit the classification record or the medical supporting documents for the Organizer's review by the entry deadline (March 24, 2023). For Visually Impaired, we will arrange Classification after the team arrives in Hong Kong.
5. Equipment: NO equipment check will be conducted.  
All athletes are responsible for bringing their own bowling balls.  
TPB1 athletes must bring their own guiderails.
