8. <u>Visa Information</u>

No visa for entry is required for more than 150 countries/regions. However, the visa-free period may vary among countries/regions. The entry forms are NOT valid as visas. All countries/ regions should confirm visa information independently by checking the Visa Guidelines and Requirements of the Department of Foreign Affairs (https://www.dfa.gov.ph/guidelines-requirements) and Guidelines on the Entry of Temporary Visitors to the Philippines (https://www.dfa.gov.ph/list-of-countries-for-21-day-visa). The application process may take



more than 6 weeks' time. Applicants for temporary visitor's visa should normally apply at the Philippine Embassy or Consulate that has jurisdiction over their place of residence. While some visa applicants may apply at any Philippine Embassy or Consulate abroad, others are only allowed to apply his/her visa at the Philippine Embassy or Consulate in his country of origin or legal residence.

For minors below 15 yrs. old travelling without a parent to the Philippines, a Waiver of Exclusion Ground (WEG) under Section 29 (a)(12) of the Philippine Immigration Act of 1940, as amended is required. For more information, please visit https://www.dfa.gov.ph/guidelines-requirements.

9. Fees

Entry Fee for Delegation

The 19th Asian Youth Tenpin Bowling Championships entry fee is US\$200 per person. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation, participation in Opening Ceremony, Welcome Reception, and the Victory Banquet.

Entry Fee for Guests/Supporters

The Entry fee for guests and supporters is US\$150 per person. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation, entry into the bowling center, participation in Opening Ceremony, Welcome Reception, and the Victory Banquet. Guests and supporters may reserve rooms in the official hotels subject to availability of rooms in each hotel.

Press Officials

Unless they have other duties (another capacity) related to a team or federation at the 19th Asian Youth Tenpin Bowling Championships, there will be **no entry fee** for accredited press officials except for participation in the Victory Banquet. Banquet fee for press is US\$50 per person.
