The World Tenpin Bowling Championships for Youth (World Youth Championships) will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 4 and Chapter 6 of World Tenpin Bowling Association Statutes and Playing Rules as of January 2014.

1. Introduction of Hong Kong, China

Hong Kong is situated on the southeast coast of China at the mouth of the Pearl River facing the South China Sea. Covering an area of 1,104 square kilometres (425 square miles). It comprises Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New Territories, which includes 262 outlying islands. At the core is Victoria Harbour, which separates Hong Kong Island from Kowloon and beyond that, the New Territories that runs up to the boundary with Mainland China. As well as making up the bulk of Hong Kong's land mass, the New Territories also incorporates 262 outlying islands, including Lantau where the airport is located.

Under the unique principle of 'One Country, Two Systems', Hong Kong returned to Chinese sovereignty on 1 July 1997 as a Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China. This arrangement allows Hong Kong to enjoy a high degree of autonomy, retaining its capitalist system, independent judiciary and rule of law, free trade and freedom of speech.

Hong Kong offers a host of memorable tourist attractions within its compact area, with The Peak, Victoria Harbour and the Giant Buddha among the most awe-inspiring. You'll be amazed by the diverse contrasts and close proximity of stunning cityscapes and soaring mountains, heritage sites and extensive green countryside. 8. Visa Information

No visa for entry is required for more than 170 countries/ regions. However, the visa-free period may vary among countries/ regions. The entry forms are **NOT** valid as visas. All countries/ regions should confirm visa information independently by checking "Part II of Visit Visa/ Entry Permit Requirements for the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region" from the Immigration Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (www.immd.gov.hk/ehtml/hkvisas 4.htm#part2). Visa application form could be found in http://www.immd.gov.hk/en/forms/hk-visas/visit-transit.html. The application process may take more than <u>6 weeks</u> time. All visa applications have to be done by Hong Kong SAR Immigration Department and not through the Chinese Embassy in your country/territory. We earnestly request that all filled out forms should be email to HKTBC **at least 2 months** before the commencement of the championship to facilitate our processing with the HKSAR Immigration Department.

9. <u>Fees</u>

Entry Fee for Delegation

The World Youth Championships entry fee is US\$250 per person for all players, coaches and administrators as well as any extra of the official delegation. These fees include and cover accreditation card, transportation, participation in Opening Ceremony and the Victory Banquet.

Entry Fee for Guests/ Supporters

The entry fee for guests and supporters is US\$250 per person. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation, entry into bowling venue, participation in the Opening Ceremony and the Victory Banquet. Guests and supporters may reserve rooms in the official hotels subject to availability of rooms in each hotel.

Press Officials

Unless they have other duties (another capacity) related to a team or federation at the World Youth Championships, there will be **no entry fee** for accredited press officials <u>except for participation in the Victory Banquet</u>. Banquet fee for press is US\$50 per person.
