



26th MILO STORM U22 INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR ALL-STARS BOWLING CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZATION & SANCTION

The 26th MILO STORM U22 International Junior All-Stars Bowling Championship is organized by Sunway Mega Lanes and sanctioned by Malaysian Tenpin Bowling Congress, Asian Bowling Federation and International Bowling Federation.

It will be conducted in accordance to World Bowling Playing Rules as of September 2019.

2. ELIGIBILITY

All current MTBC members of good standing and foreign bowlers accredited by their respective Congress/ Federation/ Association are eligible to participate in this Championship. All overseas participants must obtain clearance from their respective National Tenpin Bowling Association.

3. AVERAGES

For local participants, grading will be based on Junior Circuit and the official averages of MTBC (74) and bowler without established average must produce written confirmation of their averages from their respective Associations. Overseas bowlers must submit a certification or proof of their averages as attested by their officials. Lower grade participants are allowed to bowl in the Open.

Category 12 & under and 15 & under does not need to bowl for Singles event. The first attempt for Graded, Open and Super Junior must be a Singles event. No refund shall be made after an entry has been registered and accepted.

5. EVENTS & MASTERS

5.1 12YEARS & UNDER

Qualifying scores based on 3 games.

Top 48 boys (10 local pool + 10 overseas pool + 28 mixed pool) and top 30 girls (8 local pool + 8 overseas pool + 14 mixed pool) will bowl 8 games scratch.

Top 3 will proceed to Step Ladder. The 3rd and 2nd position bowler to bowl one game. 2nd highest pinfall to take 3rd position. Highest pinfall to proceed to meet the 1st placed bowler for a 1+1 game format. If the 1st placed bowler wins the 1st game, he/she shall be declared as Champion. If the 1st placed bowler loses the 1st game, there would be a "sudden death" play-off on 1 game. Whoever wins this game shall be declared the Champion

Last squad for qualifying is on 6 December 2026 at 6.30pm.

Final on 7 December 2026. Check in at 7.00am – 7.45am. Roll off at 8.00am. Reserves will be called 7.46am.

5.2 15 YEARS & UNDER

Qualifying scores based on 3 games.

Top 48 boys (10 local pool + 10 overseas pool + 10 mixed pool) and top 30 girls (10 local pool + 10 overseas pool + 10 mixed pool) will bowl 8 games scratch.

Top 3 will proceed to Step Ladder. The 3rd and 2nd position bowler to bowl one game. 2nd highest pinfall to take 3rd position. Highest pinfall to proceed to meet the 1st placed bowler for a 1+1 game format. If the 1st placed bowler wins the 1st game, he/she shall be declared as Champion. If the 1st placed bowler loses the 1st game, there would be a “sudden death” play-off on 1 game. Whoever wins this game shall be declared the Champion

Last squad for qualifying is on 7 December 2026 at 6.30pm.

Final on 8 December 2026. Check in at 7.00am – 7.45am. Roll off at 8.00am. Reserves will be called 7.46am.

5.3 GRADED

Qualifying scores based on 3 games.

This event open to boys averaging 190 and below and girls average 180 and below.

Last squad for qualifying is on 11 December 2026 at 6.30pm

Top 45 boys and 27 girls finalist will bowl 10 games scratch. Total pinfalls to decide the winner.

Final on 12 December 2026. Check in at 8.00am – 8.45am. Roll off at 9.00am. Reserves will be called 8.46am.

5.4 OPEN

Qualifying scores based 6 games (best of 2 MQs’)

Last squad for qualifying is on 11 December 2026 at 9.00pm

Round 1 final on 12 December 2026. Check in at 2.00pm – 2.45pm. Roll off at 3.00pm Reserves will be called 2.46pm

Round 2 final on 13 December 2026. Check in at 8.00am – 8.45am. Roll off at 9.00am

ROUND 4 (Finals)	The 1 st placed bowler from Round 2 and winner from Round 3 will meet in the Finals. The Finals will be held on a 1+1 game format. If the top placed bowler wins the 1 st game, he shall be declared as Champion. Should the winner from Round 3 wins the 1 st game, there would be a “sudden death” play-off on 1 game. Whoever wins this game shall be declared the Champion.	The 1 st placed bowler from Round 2 and winner from Round 3 will meet in the Finals. The Finals will be held on a 1+1 game format. If the top placed bowler wins the 1 st game, he shall be declared as Champion. Should the winner from Round 3 wins the 1 st game, there would be a “sudden death” play-off on 1 game. Whoever wins this game shall be declared the Champion.

5.5 SUPER JUNIOR

Qualifying scores based on 3 games.

Handicap for girls is 7 pins each game.

Top 30 qualifiers will 10 games scratch, total pinfalls to decide the winners.

Last squad for qualifying is on 12 December 2026 at 10.30pm

Final on 13 December 2026. Check in at 4.00pm – 4.45pm. Roll off at 5.00pm. Reserves will be called 4.46pm

6. SQUAD TIMES

If preferred squad times indicated on the entry forms are not available, the Tournament Directors or Assistants reserve the right to reallocate squad times at their discretion. The Tournament Directors reserve the right to open additional squads.

All qualifiers must check with the Tournament Director 24 hours before their final roll-off, to confirm their fixtures and/or check for any changes in the schedule.

7. REGISTRATION OF BOWLING BALLS, ILLEGALITY AND DISQUALIFICATION

SLOW OIL-ABSORBING HIGH PERFORMANCE (URETHANE) BOWLING BALLS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE USED. Penalty will be zero points for the MQ Attempt. If used during the finals, the athlete will be DISQUALIFIED from the tournament.

- ALL urethane balls (including Japan and Korea OEM urethanes)
- ALL urethane mixed coverstocks, such as: MicroCell Polymers (MCP), React-a-Thanes, PBS Urethane Mix, Pyramid GPS Navigational Urethanes

All participants are advised to check their bowling balls used in the tournament are within the specifications for weight and other specifications before they compete in their events. The onus is on the bowler to ensure that all balls he/she uses are within the specifications in accordance with International Bowling Federation Rules.

If at any time a bowler is found to have used an illegal ball even if previously certified legal by the Tournament Office, he/she shall be disqualified from the entire Tournament and stripped of all his/her winnings or positions standing.

8. ALTERING OF BOWLING BALL SURFACE

Altering the surface of bowling balls is allowed only during the practice session. A player may not alter the surface of the bowling ball after a game or in between games.

9. TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES

- 9.1** When a tie occurs for the last place in the Masters' Qualifying (oversea / local pool), the player with the highest last game shall determine the positions.
- 9.2** If a tie exists in (9.1) after the tie-breaker, a one ball roll-off will be utilized and/or repeated until the tie is broken.
- 9.3** When a tie occurs during the Step-Ladder Semi-Finals & Finals, a one ball roll-off will be utilized and/or repeated until the tie is broken.
- 9.4** When a tie occurs which affects progress to the Round 2, Step-Ladder Semi Finals; positions of Semi-Finalists and the leader; a one game roll-off shall be bowl.
- 9.5** When a tie is registered which will affect the awards of prizes, the prizes will be shared equally among the winners.

10. AWARDS

Prizes in the form of Cash Vouchers will be awarded to the winners.

11. VERIFICATIONS OF SCORES

It is the bowlers' responsibility to ensure that the correct score for each game is recorded in the official score sheet by signing on the official score sheet.

12. BOWLERS ATTIRE

12.1 Bowlers are requested to be dressed for their events with a sense of decorum.

12.2 Men bowlers are not permitted to wear jeans, shorts, singlet and caps while women bowlers are not permitted to wear jeans and cap.

13. PROTEST

13.1 Scores : Must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Directors or their Assistants within 12 hours of the event. No protest made after the prize presentation will be entertained.

13.2 Eligibility : Must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Directors or their Assistants within 12 hours of the first infringement.

14. SPECIAL NOTES

The Tournament Directors, or, in his absence, his appointed official on duty, reserves the right to accept or reject any entry as deem fit. Any matters arising which are not covered in these Rules and Regulations will be decided by the Tournament Directors. The decision of the Tournament Directors shall be final. Such appeal should be made in writing and within 12 hours of the decision by any of the above.
