This tournament will be conducted as an individual event

Event

Tournament : Lane moves after each block of 4 games.

Format : Qualifying Round: 8 games. The best 48 bowlers will be qualified for semi-final.

Semi-final: 4 games. The best **12** bowlers will be qualified for the Final Rounds based on the total scores of 12 games.

Final:

1st Round: 1 game matches between 12 qualifiers from Semi-final. Bowlers will be assigned to the lanes according to attached the tournament bracket.

* Losers' positions will follow those from Semi-final

2nd Round: 1 game matches between 6 winners from 1st Round

Losers' positions will follow those from Semi-final

3rd Round: 1 game elimination match between **3** winners from 2nd

Round. The lowest scored will be eliminated.

Championship match - 1 game match between 2 winners from 3rd

Round and to determine 'Fukuoka Summer Cup Champion'.

- : \diamondsuit This tournament has no separate division of genders or ages, but has a handicap system including for Final Round as follows:
 - Handicap

[Age handicap] 5 pins to junior high students

[Gender handicap] 7 pins to girls; (ex.) 12 pins to junior high girls

Tournament

: IBF Playing Rules will be applied, except for the following tie breaker:

Rules

A tie on the cut line to Semi-final/Final:

- ① The highest positioned should be the one with the least difference between 4-game blocks bowled up to then.
- ② In case a tie still exists, the highest positioned should be the one with the least difference between the highest and the lowest game of the games he/she bowled up to then.
- ③ In case a tie still exists, the highest positioned should be the one with the most strikes.
- ④ In case a tie still exists, the highest positioned should be the one with the most spares.
- ⑤ In case a tie still exists, one shot roll-off will be conducted until the tie breaks.

A tie in any match of Final;

One shot roll-off will be conducted until the tie breaks.

※ One shot roll-off will, the highest scored in the previous block or match (in Final) will select the lane and the order to bowl.

Eligibility : Bowlers born from 2003 to 2012.

Certification is needed from ABF member federation for participation.

Entry Fee : ¥ 15,000 Japanese Yen.

(Payable in only JPY.)

Awards : U22: Prize Money, supplementary prize and bowling equipments will be awarded

to the winners of 1st - 12th position by Storm.

U15: Bowling Balls will be awarded to the winners of 1st -10th position by Storm *U15 division is for athletes aged 15 and under, and there will be no finals,

just awards.

Prize Money : Champion - JPY300,000, 2nd positioned - JPY150,000,

3rd positioned - JPY120,000, 4th positioned - JPY90,000

 $5^{\mathrm{th}}-8^{\mathrm{th}}$ positioned-JPY35,000, $9^{\mathrm{th}}-12^{\mathrm{th}}$ positioned-JPY20,000

Supplementary : Prize money, Storm local staff, and bowling balls for winners. 2nd to 12th

Prize places will receive prize money and bowling balls from Storm. And there

are bowling balls and bowling equipment in the 13th place and below.

U15 Division: 1st to 10th places will each receive a bowling ball.

If U15 athletes finish higher than 12th place, they can receive prize money

and supplementary prizes.

*The maximum number of athletes is 192 on a first-come, first-served basis.

Ball registration : Athletes should submit bowl lists on day one. The Organizing Committee may

check athletes' balls at random.

No limitation of the number of bowling balls to be registered, but only 4 balls are

allowed to be in the bowlers area.

All urethane balls will be prohibited at this tournament. This is a measure aimed at improving the competitive ability and techniques of young athletes under the age of 22. Thank you for your understanding.
